

GEOGRAPHICAL NAMES ACT 1966

Anti-Discrimination Act 1977

EXEMPTION ORDER

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW), an exemption is given from sections 8, 19 and 51 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW) to City of Parramatta Council to:

- advertise, designate and recruit the position of Keeping Place Officer for an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person only; and
- provide access to sacred materials held at Keeping Place to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders only.

This exemption will remain in force for 10 years.

Anti-Discrimination Act 1977

EXEMPTION ORDER

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW), an exemption is given from sections 8 and 51 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW) to the NSW Aboriginal Land Council to advertise, designate and recruit roles for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people only in pursuance of its goal of a 75% Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander workforce participation rate.

This exemption will remain in force for 5 years.

EXEMPTION ORDER
