REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Lake Mulwala – near the locality of the Mulwala Water Ski Club and within an area bounded by:

- The Mulwala foreshore between the land-based localities of the Lake Edge Resort and south to the Melbourne Street Bridge, then
- East into Lake Mulwala for a distance of approximately 750 metres, then
- North to a location directly east of the Lake Edge Resort.

Duration

7.00am to 6.00pm on the following dates:

Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 April 2022

Detail

Competitive powerboat racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Mulwala at the location and times specified above, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control and patrol vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit Lane

A 'transit lane' will be established along the foreshore from the Lake Mulwala Holiday Park, south of the Mulwala Water Ski Club, to the Melbourne Street bridge, Mulwala, within which a control vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass through.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to Section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, special restrictions are applicable to vessels using the transit lane:

- Maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Minimal wash must be produced.

Ulladulla Harbour and Tasman Sea – waters within a 200 metre radius of the Northern Break wall of Ulladulla Harbour.

A fireworks display will be conducted over navigable waters of the Tasman Sea at the location specified above. The display will be staged from land at the above location.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event extending for a radius of 200 metres around the firing point.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone, which will monitored and maintained by event personnel and control vessels.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Murray River – near the townships of Mildura (VIC) and Gol Gol (NSW) and between the following locations:

- 7.00am to 2.00pm Saturday 16 April 2022 between the 888km River Marker upstream to the 938km river marker at Wickett's Bend
- 2.00pm to 6.00pm Saturday 16 April 2022 between the 888km River Marker upstream to the 904km river marker at Psyche Bend
- 7.00am to 6.00pm Sunday 17 April 2022 between the 888km River Marker upstream to the 938km River Marker at Wickett's Bend

Detail

Competitive ski racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River as specified above.

The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time – presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River between the locations detailed on the respective days above. The zone will be marked at each end by the presence of control vessels. Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – SPECIAL RESTRICTION

Special Event

Flooding due to heavy rain is presenting a risk to the safety of navigation, and as a result a special event has been declared for the waters of the Hawkesbury River and tributaries.

Location

All waters on the Hawkesbury River between Spencer and Windsor.

Duration

24 hours on the following days:

Friday 1 April 2022 – Friday 15 April 2022

Detail

A restriction pursuant to section 11 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998* is declared to be in place at the location for the duration specified above. The restriction is applicable to all vessels (including personal watercraft) and applies and takes precedence over any localised signage.

Special Restriction:

Pursuant to Section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998* a maximum speed limit of **15 knots** must be adhered to at all times and 'No towing of persons' is permitted.
