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## Interim Heritage Order

(Order No. OHA2022-0001)

Under Section 25 of the HERITAGE ACT 1977 Tamworth Regional Council does by this order:

- (i) *Make an interim heritage order to cover the item specified or described in Schedule 'A'; and*
- (ii) *Declare that the Interim Heritage Order shall apply to the curtilage or size of such item, being the land described in Schedule 'B'.*

*The Heritage Order will lapse six months from the date that is made unless the local council has passed a resolution before that date either:*

- 1) *In the case of an item which, in the Council's opinion, is of local significance, to place the item on the heritage schedule of a local environmental plan with appropriate provisions for protecting and managing the item; and*
- 2) *In the case of an item which in the Council's opinion, is of State heritage significance, nominate the item for inclusion on the State Heritage Register.*

The property known as 4 Darling Street, Tamworth on land described in Schedule B.

### Schedule B

All those pieces or parcels of land known as Lot 420 DP47649 in the Tamworth Regional Local Government Area.
