REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

Duration

- 8:00am to 6:00pm – Saturday 30 April 2022
- 8:00am to 6:00pm – Sunday 1 May 2022

Detail

Water Ski Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga specified above. This will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel users between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be monitored and maintained by event officials and support and control vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Location

Main Beach, Byron Bay

Duration

6.00am to 11.00am on the following dates:

- Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 May 2022

Detail

The swimming leg of a triathlon will be conducted on the navigable waters of Byron Bay in an area directly in front of the Byron Bay Surf Lifesaving Club.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by a series of high visibility inflatable buoys and rounding marks. Safety and support vessels, powered and passive, will be in attendance managing the event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone, which will also be patrolled by Maritime and Police patrol vessels.

Transit lane

Provision may be made for vessels to transit the exclusion zone. A support vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass through the exclusion zone via a 'transit lane'.


SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels using the transit lane. Vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce no wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Wategos Beach to Main Beach, Byron Bay

Duration

- 8.00am to 12.00pm noon – Sunday 1 May 2022

Detail

A swim event starting at Wategos Beach, Byron Bay will be conducted on a north/north-westerly course finishing at the Byron Bay Lifesaving Club. A shorter course will also be in use for a preliminary race commencing at 'The Pass', which will also finish at the Byron Bay Surf Lifesaving Club.

A series of small inflatable buoys will indicate the finish line-on the foreshore directly in front of the Byron Surf Lifesaving Club.

Official safety and support vessels, (both powered and passive) will be in attendance to manage the event.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event comprising the course described above. The course will be indicated by a series of high visibility mobile safety craft which will advance in a Northerly direction with the swimmers.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will also be patrolled by Maritime and Police patrol vessels.

Transit lane

Provisions may be made on a case-by-case basis for vessels to transit the Exclusion Zone. A Patrol vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course if required.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Location

Hastings River – near the locality of Port Macquarie as follows:

- Ironman Practice Swims – between the Marine Rescue boat ramp and the downstream side of the Park Street Road bridge adjacent to the Broadwater Main Canal
- Ironman Races – between the Marine Rescue boat ramp and the Broadwater Main Canal.

Duration

- 6.00am to 9.00am – Friday 29 and Saturday 30 April 2022 (Ironman Practice Swims)
- 6.00am to 11.30am – Sunday 1 May 2022 (Ironman Races)

Detail

Ironman Practice Swims and the Ironman Races will be conducted on the Hastings River at the dates and times specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events, which will be monitored and patrolled by control vessels at the above locations. The Exclusion Zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels on the perimeter of the zones.

Unauthorised vessels are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

A 'transit lane' will be established along the Hastings River within which authorised control vessels will - at times during the event - authorise local vessel traffic to cross the Exclusion Zone during breaks in the swim races.

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, **SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS** apply to all vessels using the transit lane. Vessels navigating the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots, and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Murray River – Entire width of the River at the following locations:

- Saturday, 14 May 2022 – Murray River between Perricoota Marina (at the 1690km marker) and upstream to the Victoria Park Boat Ramp, Echuca (at the 1712km marker), and
- Sunday, 15 May 2022 – Murray River between Torrumbarry Weir (at the 1630km river) and upstream to the Victoria Park Boat Ramp (at the 1712km marker).

Duration

6.00am to 7.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 May 2022

Detail

Competitive ski racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River as specified Above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using towlines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River between the locations detailed on the respective days above. The Zone will be marked at each end by the presence of patrol and control vessels. There will also be support vessels present to manage the event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
