**Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation**

Notice is hereby given, under section 5(2)(a) of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, that consultation on the draft Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation 2022 (draft Regulation) is required in accordance with section 5 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 and will commence on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

The draft Regulation contains matters that are required or permitted to be prescribed under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (Act) or that are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for giving effect to the Act. They remake the Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation 2021.
