ORDER

Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Mr Justin Selby BURT (PHA0000948648)** of Hunters Hill NSW 2110 prohibiting him, until further notice, as a pharmacist, from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture or extract of a drug of addiction, as authorised by Clauses 85, 99, 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation.

This Order is to take effect on and from 27 May 2022.

ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* a direction has been issued that the Order that took effect on and from 2 July 2021, on **Mr Anthony Joseph Ayoub (PHA0001868507)** of Five Dock NSW 2046, prohibiting him as a pharmacist from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture or extract of a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 26 May 2022.
