### Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **James Michael Grey (PAR0002207544)**, of BAULKHAM HILLS NSW 2153, prohibiting him, as an ambulance officer employed by NSW Ambulance from having possession of or supplying a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 101(1) of the Regulation.

#### ORDER

### Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Dr George Jim Leslie Jacobs (MED0001065560)**, of BONDI JUNCTION NSW 2022, prohibiting him until further notice, as a medical practitioner, from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation.
