Talbingo Reservoir, Talbingo - between the Dam Wall and an area approximately 9km to Point Monster including Honeysuckle and Waterfall Bays.

- Sunday 19 June 2022

Detail

A high speed powerboat trial will be conducted on the navigable waters of Talbingo Reservoir during the dates and times specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event at the location above which will be indicated by the presence of control vessels on the perimeters.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be monitored by control vessels.


Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be monitored by control vessels.

MINISTERIAL ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 19

Ministerial (Learner Approved Motorcycle Exemption) Order 2022

I, Natalie Ward, Minister for Metropolitan Roads, pursuant to section 19(1) of the *Road Transport Act 2013*, make this Order.

1. Citation

This Order is the ***Ministerial (Learner Approved Motorcycle Exemption) Order 2022***.

2. Commencement

This Order has effect on and from the date of publication in the NSW Government Gazette.

3. Effect

This Order remains in force until 30 June 2024 unless revoked earlier.

4. Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as in road transport legislation, unless otherwise stated.

5. Definitions

In this Order the following are defined:

Motor bike rider means a person who holds a NSW Learner Licence or Provisional P1 or P2 driver's licence and has a physical disability that requires a motor bike to be modified to enable that person to ride a motor bike safely.

6. Declaration

Clauses 17(2), 22(1)(b) and 29(1)(b) of the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017 are declared not to apply to a motor bike rider, as defined under Clause 5 of the Order and subject to the conditions at clause 7 of this Order.

7. Conditions

The conditions for this Order are:

- (a) The motor bike rider must have an exemption letter approved and signed by the Director Safe Systems & Programs, Transport for NSW.
- (b) The motor bike rider must comply with conditions (if any) stated in the exemption letter.
- (c) The motor bike rider must carry the exemption letter at all times when riding the motor bike and produce the exemption letter, when requested to do so by a police officer or authorised person.

8. Publication

This Order is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

Explanatory notes:

The object of this Order is to exempt a person with a physical disability from being required to ride a motor bike that is listed in Transport for NSW's publication *Approved motorcycles for novice riders* (pursuant to clauses 17(2), 22(1)(b) and 29(1)(b) of the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017) while they hold either a learner licence or provisional P1 and P2 licence.
