SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION ACT 1989
Proposed Forestry Regulation 2022

The Minister for Agriculture proposes to make the Forestry Regulation 2022 (**Forestry Regulation**).

For the purposes of section 5(2)(a) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*:

- (a) The Forestry Regulation will make regulations that are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to the *Forestry Act 2012* (**Forestry Act**). The *Forestry Act* ensures that the management and use of State forests is efficient and environmentally sustainable and consistent with the principles of ecologically sustainable development.
- (b) The Forestry Regulation will replace the Forestry Regulation 2012, which will be automatically repealed on 1 September 2022. The Forestry Regulation maintains many of the existing regulations in the Forestry Regulation 2012, and prescribes new regulations authorising and regulating beekeeping and grazing activities in forestry areas.

Proposed Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2022

The exposure draft of the proposed Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2022 is now available for public comment.

The proposed Regulation will re-make the existing Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2014 with some amendments, as part of the staged repeal of statutory rules under the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

The object of the proposed Regulation is to make provision about the health and safety of workers at mine and petroleum sites. A regulatory impact statement (RIS) has been prepared examining the need for the proposed Regulation and its costs and benefits.

The proposed Regulation and RIS are currently on public exhibition and are available for inspection on the Department of Regional NSW's Mining, Exploration and Geoscience website at www.resourcesregulator.nsw.gov.au/our-role/legislation/public-consultation

SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION ACT 1989
Proposed Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2022

The Minister for Agriculture proposes to make the Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2022 (**GFAC Regulation**).

For the purposes of section 5(2)(a) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*:

- (a) The GFAC Regulation will make regulations that are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2012 (GFAC Act)*. The *GFAC Act* provides for the effective management of introduced species of game animals and promote responsible and orderly hunting of those game animals on public and private land and certain pest animal on public land.
- (b) The GFAC Regulation 2022 will replace the GFAC Regulation 2012, which will be automatically repealed on 1 September 2022. The GFAC Regulation maintains many of the existing regulations in the GFAC Regulation 2012 and prescribes new regulations designed to improve safe and responsible hunting in NSW.
