Schedule 1 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Care Services) Order (No 2) 2022

[1] Clause 6 Introduction

Insert at the end of clause 6—

Note— The operator of a residential aged care facility must consider the advice of the Chief Health Officer in relation to certain matters, including the management of visitors to the facility. See the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 2) 2022*, clause 9.

[2] Clause 9 Restrictions on visitors to residential aged care facilities

Omit the clause.

[3] Clauses 12 and 15

Omit “clause 7, 8 or 9(3)” wherever occurring in clauses 12(1) and (2) and 15(2).

Insert instead “clause 7 or 8”.

[4] Clause 13 Exemptions for medical contraindications

Omit “9(3),”.
