ABORIGINAL LAND RIGHTS ACT 1983

NOTICE

I, the Honourable Ben Franklin MLC, Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, following approval by the New South Wales Aboriginal Land Council, do, by this notice pursuant to section 231(2) of the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (the ALRA) and sections 36(3) and 48(1) of the Interpretation Act 1987, extend the appointment of Mr Timothy Gumbleton as Administrator to the Stuart Island Tribal Elders Descendants Local Aboriginal Land Council for a period of three (3) calendar months, from 25 June 2022. During the period of his appointment, the Administrator will have all of the functions of the Stuart Island Tribal Elders Descendants Local Aboriginal Land Council and any other duties as specified by the instrument of appointment.
