EXEMPTION ORDER

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW), an exemption is given from sections 8, 19, 25, 33 and 51 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act* 1977 (NSW) to McKinsey & Company to advertise, designate and recruit up to:

- 20 management consultant internships or scholarships for women only and;
- 5 management consultant internships or scholarships for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders only.

This exemption will remain in force for 10 years.
