ORDER

Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979

Declaration under section 4.36(3)

I, the Minister for Planning, with the advice of the Independent Planning Commission (dated 19 July 2022 and made publicly available on 19 July 2022), declare the development specified in Schedule 1 on the land specified in Schedule 2 to be State significant development under section 4.36(3) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, for the purposes of that Act.

SCHEDULE 1

Development for the purposes of a flight training centre at 28-30 Burrows Road, St Peters, as described in LOGOS Development Management Pty Ltd (LOGOS) in partnership with Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) and CAE Inc. request for SSD call-in, submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment and dated May 2022.
