### ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, Sydney 19 August 2022

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 36 — An Act to amend the *Casino Control Act 1992* and the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007* to implement recommendations of the Casino Inquiry Report by the Hon P A Bergin SC, including establishing the New South Wales Independent Casino Commission as a new independent regulator; to extinguish compensation triggers for casino operators in relation to regulatory action taken by Parliament, the Government and the Commission; and for related purposes. **[Casino Legislation Amendment Bill]**

Act No. 37 — An Act to amend the *Crimes Act 1900* to create an offence for knowingly displaying Nazi symbols by public act and without reasonable excuse. **[Crimes Amendment (Prohibition on Display of Nazi Symbols) Bill]**

Act No. 38 — An Act to revoke the reservation of certain land under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*; and for related purposes. **[National Parks and Wildlife Amendment (Reservations) Bill]**

Act No. 39 — An Act to make various amendments to the *Ombudsman Act 1974* and the *Community Services (Complaints, Reviews and Monitoring) Act 1993*. **[Ombudsman Legislation Amendment Bill]**
