REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Manning River, Taree - adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree between the Martin Bridge & the Manning River Rowing Club building at Endeavour Place boat ramp

Duration

7.00am to 4.30pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 September 2022

Detail

Dragon Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Manning River, Taree specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified for the location between the above times. The Zone will consist of a 200 metre course marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone

Transit Lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Richmond River, Woodburn - Court Street Road Bridge

Duration

- 6.30pm to 8.30pm - Saturday 17 September 2022

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of the Richmond River specified above and will be launched from the Court Street Road Bridge. The area directly around the firing position may be dangerous and hazardous during the event.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by buoys and form a radius of 75 metres around the firing position.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be monitored by control vessels.

Transit Lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
