
ABORIGINAL LAND RIGHTS ACT 1983

NOTICE

*I, the Honourable Ben Franklin MLC, Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, following approval by the New South Wales Aboriginal Land Council (NSWALC), do, by this notice pursuant to section 222(1) of the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (the Act), appoint Mr Andrew Bowcher as Administrator to the Baradine Local Aboriginal Land Council ((Baradine LALC), for a period of six calendar months. During the period of his appointment, the Administrator will have all the functions of Baradine LALC, the Board of the Baradine LALC, and the members of the Baradine LALC exercised by resolution of the members of the Baradine LALC, and subject to section 230 of the Act, and any other duties as specified by the agreed terms of appointment. The Administrator's remuneration and expenses are not to exceed \$10,110 excluding GST per month, without the prior approval of NSWALC. The Administrator's remuneration may include fees payable for the services of other personnel within the Administrator's firm who provide services as agents of the Administrator.*
