REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

Duration

- 8:00am to 6:00pm – Saturday 24 September 2022
- 8:00am to 2:00pm – Sunday 25 September 2022

Detail

Power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be monitored by event staff and support vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Sydney Harbour – Lavender Bay, extending 150 metres both north and south of an imaginary line drawn due east from McMahons Point to Milsons Point

Duration

- 9.20pm to 10.00pm - Monday 19 September 2022

Detail

A drone light and sound show will take place at the location specified above. Due to the potential to affect the safety of navigation and to safeguard the event, this Notice establishes an Exclusion Zone around the activity.

Exclusion Zone

An Exclusion Zone will be established at the time specified above. The Zone will be enforced by a Transport for NSW (Maritime) patrol vessel as per the attached map.

Any vessel operator or person entering the Exclusion Zone is liable to an offence (*Marine Safety Act 1998 s.12(5)* - Maximum Penalty \$1,100.00)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Lower Myall River – entire width of the river from Myall St Bridge, adjacent Tea Gardens to Tamboy village

Duration

- 7.30am to 3.00pm - Saturday 17 September 2022

Detail

A number of competitive paddle craft events will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lower Myall River specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be monitored by control vessels stationed around the perimeter.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions


Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Fingal Bay, Port Stephens – adjacent to the Fingal Bay Surf Life Saving Club

Detail

A number of swim events will be conducted on the navigable waters of Fingal Bay, Port Stephens specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed around the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.
