# Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022

under the

Public Health Act 2010

## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to remove the requirement to wear fitted face coverings—

- (a) in an indoor area at a cruise terminal, or
- (b) at a public transport waiting area, or
- (c) in a vehicle or vessel being used to provide a public transport service.

This Order also removes redundant provisions from the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Order 2022*.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Amendment (No 1) Order 2022*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences at the beginning of 21 September 2022.

### **3 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) Order 2022**

**Clauses 6(1)(a)(i) and (b) and (3) and 7(3)(g) and (h) and Schedule 1, definitions of “public transport service”, “public transport waiting area” and “vehicle”**

Omit the provisions.
