REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Moruya River – the entirety of the river from the Moruya Bridge to 500 metres downstream, adjacent to the Moruya Riverside Park, near the township of Moruya

Duration

- 5.00pm to 12.00am – Friday 23 September 2022
- 4.00pm to 9.30pm – Saturday 24 September 2022

Detail

A lighting and laser show will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Moruya River specified above. It will be staged both from land and a temporary structure within the river that will house water jets and projection equipment.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of the Moruya River between the locations detailed above. The Zone will be monitored by event staff and control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Sydney Harbour – Farm Cove

Duration

- 3.30pm - 6.00pm – Tuesday 4 October 2022

Detail

A special event will take place on Sydney Harbour at location specified above, being the Red Bull Heli Dive event. It will involve a helicopter briefly hovering at low level to enable a professional diver to dive from the helicopter and into the waters of Sydney Harbour.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by a perimeter of yellow buoys, as per the attached map, and will be patrolled by Maritime vessels and monitored by other control vessels.

The Zone will only be activated for an appropriate timeframe within the above window to safely enable the event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

**POINT TO POINT TRANSPORT (COROWA WAHGUNYAH RUTHERGLEN TAXIS)
EXEMPTION ORDER 2022**

under the

Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hires Vehicles) Regulation 2017

I, Anthony Wing, Point to Point Transport Commissioner, do pursuant to clause 92 of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hires Vehicles) Regulation 2017* make the following Order.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Point to Point Transport (Corowa Wahgunyah Rutherglen Taxis) Exemption Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This order commences on the date it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

3 Effect

This Order remains in force up to and including 1 November 2027 unless revoked earlier.

4 Interpretation

Words and expressions in this Order have the same meaning in the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hires Vehicles) Act 2016* or the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hires Vehicles) Regulation 2017* unless otherwise stated.

Act means the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016*.

Corowa Wahgunyah Rutherglen Taxis means Giovanni Nominees Pty Ltd (trading as Corowa Wahgunyah Rutherglen Taxis).

5 Exemption

Corowa Wahgunyah Rutherglen Taxis is exempt from the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the Act subject to the condition at clause 6.

6 Condition

The nominated manager's residence must be located within 30km of Corowa NSW.

Note: An exemption that is conditional ceases to have effect if the condition is not observed.

Explanatory note

This Exemption Order exempts Giovanni Nominees Pty Ltd (trading as Corowa Wahgunyah Rutherglen Taxis) from the requirement under section 31(3)(c) of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* that at least one of the directors or managers nominated is a resident of New South Wales until 1 November 2027.

Detail

A special event will take place on Sydney Harbour at the location specified above, being the 'ICC T20 World Cup Biggest Hit' promotional event.

Celebrity batters will be invited to hit balls into the Harbour by way of a competition. A NSW Surf Lifesaving guard will collect the used balls within the Exclusion Zone.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by a perimeter of yellow buoys, as per the attached map. The Zone will also be patrolled by Maritime patrol vessels and monitored by other control vessels.

Unauthorized vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.
