Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted over navigable waters of the Manning River. Fireworks will be launched from a moored barge and the area directly around this firing position may be hazardous during the display.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be monitored and indicated by the presence of a control vessel stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Tasman Sea adjoining Wollongong Harbour and waters within Wollongong Harbour defined by:

1. the shoreline of Wollongong Harbour adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road, to
2. the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the Wollongong Slipway, to
3. the entrance into the Wollongong Harbour from the Tasman Sea, to
4. a point extending approximately 30 meters past the Northern Break wall into the Tasman Sea.

Duration

- 7.00am to 12.00pm – Thursday 26 January 2023

Detail

The swimming leg of a triathlon will be conducted at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will be indicated by the presence of course rounding buoys. The Zone will extend for 20 metres outside the course rounding buoys on all sides and will be monitored by control vessels stationed around the boundary.

Location

Murray River – near Albury, between the Hume Dam Wall (downstream) to Noreuil Park

Duration

- 2.00pm to 8.00pm - Saturday 21 January 2023
- 9.00am to 3.00pm - Sunday 22 January 2023

Detail

A canoe and kayak event will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River specified above.

Due to the risk to safe navigation and the nature and number of participating vessels, a Regulated Area will be created at the above times within which **Special Restrictions** will be imposed. The Regulated Area will comprise the entire width of the Murray River, and will extend 200 metres ahead and 200 metres to the stern of the competing vessels.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, **powered vessels** operating in the Regulated Area:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Darling River, from Menindee Weir downstream to the Murray and Darling River Junction

Duration

- 12.00am Friday 13 January 2023 until further notice.

Special Restrictions

Due to high river levels and flooding presenting a risk to the safety of navigation, a Regulated Area will be created between the above times within which **Special Restrictions** are imposed. The Regulated Area will comprise of the area within the location specified above.

Within the Regulated Area, the following Special Restrictions apply:

- (a) A Speed Limit of 15 knots applies to all vessels;
- (b) Towing of persons is prohibited;
- (c) Vessels must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 11(4) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

NOTE: Some locations within the Regulated Area may be subject to additional restrictions or prohibitions imposed by the NSW State Emergency Service under the *State Emergency Services Act 1989*.
