### ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, Sydney 27 September 2023

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 24 — An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund sums for the services of the Government for the year 2023-24. **[Appropriation Bill]**

Act No. 25 — An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund a sum for the services of the Legislature for the year 2023-24. **[Appropriation (Parliament) Bill]**

Act No. 26 — An Act to amend various Acts administered by the Treasurer and the Minister for Finance; and to transfer unspent money from 3 funds in the Special Deposits Account to the Consolidated Fund. **[Treasury and Revenue Legislation Amendment Bill]**

Act No. 27 — An Act to amend the *City of Sydney Act 1988* to remove special provisions that apply to elections for the Council of the City of Sydney; to dissolve the Central Sydney Traffic and Transport Committee and remove provisions relating to the Committee; and for related purposes. **[City of Sydney Amendment Bill]**
