MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007
Section 109
Declaration of Mental Health Facility

I, DR BRENDAN FLYNN, Executive Director, Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary, NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, DO HEREBY:

(a) DECLARE the following premises of **Westmead Hospital**, Corner of Hawkesbury Road and Darcy Road, Westmead NSW 2145, to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- **K7A Mental Health Unit**, located in Building K, Level 7, Wing A; and

(b) DECLARE this facility in the “mental health assessment and inpatient treatment class” facility.

- for a term starting at the start of 28 November 2023 and ending at the end of 27 November 2024: Dr Philip Hungerford.


