## ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO

Legislative Council Office Sydney 24 October 2023

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the undermentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 28, 2023 – An Act to amend the Motor Dealers and Repairers Act 2013 to give effect to the recommendations of a statutory review of that Act; and for other purposes. [**Motor Dealers and Repairers Amendment Bill 2023**]

Act No. 29, 2023 – An Act to amend the Mining Act 1992 to provide for the validation of certain mineral claims and matters relating to the mineral claims. [**Mining Amendment (Mineral Claims—Opal) Bill 2023**]

Act No. 30, 2023 – An Act to amend the Radiation Control Act 1990 to give effect to recommendations arising from the statutory review of the Act; and for related purposes. [**Radiation Control Amendment Bill 2023**]
