## MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007 Section 109 Revocation and Declaration of Mental Health Facility

- I, DR BRENDAN FLYNN, Acting Executive Director, Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary, NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, DO HEREBY:
- (a) **REVOKE** the Order published in the NSW Government Gazette, number 146 of 9 April 2021, declaring the Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre, located within the Clinical Services Building, Building 60, Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital, Corner of Palmerston Road and Burdett Street, Hornsby NSW 2077 as a declared mental health facility in accordance with section 109 of the Mental Health Act 2007; and
- (b) **DECLARE** the following premises of **Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital** to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:
  - The **Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre**, located on Level 1 of Building 50, Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital, Palmerston Road, Hornsby NSW 2077; and
- (c) **DECLARE** this facility to be designated a "mental health assessment and inpatient treatment" class facility.
