### Restoration of drug authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008*, the Order served on **Dr Mengyi Chen** (MED0001193832) of Burwood NSW 2134, that took effect on and from 14 November 2014 prohibiting her as a medical practitioner from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 10 March 2023.
