POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS ACT 1966
APPOINTMENT OF AN ANALYST

I, Monique Reyes, Acting Deputy Chief Pharmacist, NSW Ministry of Health, as a duly appointed delegate of the Minister for Health, in accordance with section 37A(1) and (3) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966* ("the Act"), do hereby:

REVOKE all previous instruments appointing any persons or class of persons employed or engaged by the Australian Federal Police as analysts under section 37A(1) of the Act.

APPOINT the class of persons being Crime Scene Investigators as analysts, for the purposes of section 37A(1) of the Act.

In this Instrument, Crime Scenes Investigator means a person who:

- (a) is employed or engaged from time to time by the Forensics Command of the Australian Federal Police; and
- (b) has completed the relevant Preliminary Illicit Drug Identification training conducted by the Australian Federal Police.

This appointment expires on 10 April 2025, unless it is suspended, surrendered or cancelled prior.
