A swimming leg of a triathlon will be conducted on the navigable waters of Byron Bay specified above. The event course will be established directly in front of the Byron Bay Surf Lifesaving Club extending in an Easterly direction for approximately 1,500 metres.

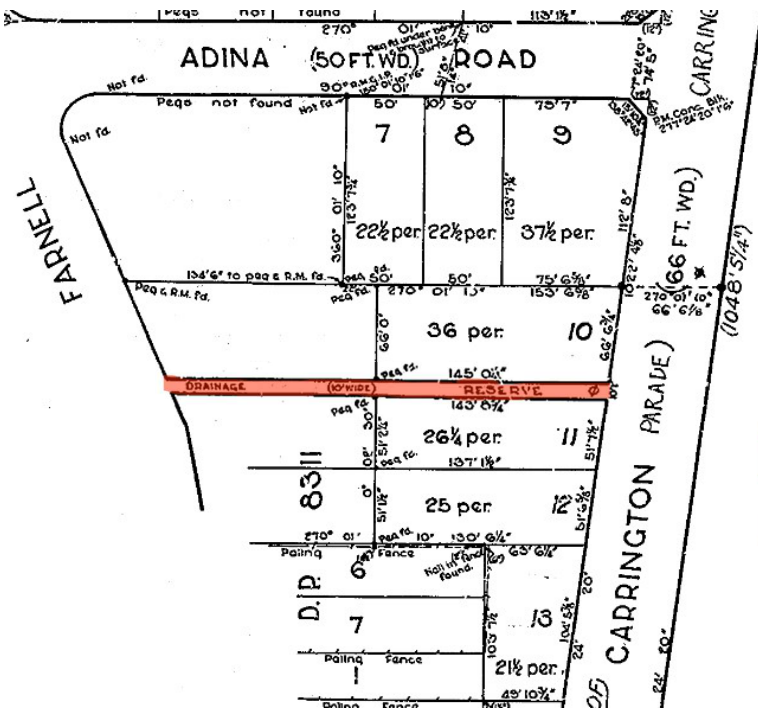

Detail

Water Ski Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga as specified above. This will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will be monitored and maintained by event officials and control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone

Detail

A competitive powerboat racing event, the Upper Hawkesbury Power Boat Club (UHPBC) Double Dash, will be conducted on the Hawkesbury River – as specified above – involving the use of high-speed powerboats which will be active in the area during the above times.

Purposes for which the land will be used under the proposed licences

The land will be used for works to upgrade Hill Road and surrounding roads, and to widen the roadway.

In particular, the Licensee may use the land for:

- the carrying out of the works, including the construction, operation and maintenance of roads including maintaining any traffic signalling equipment and includes road work;
- undertaking temporary road work including installing and removing fencing, storing of plant or equipment and undertaking environmental assessments;
- repairing any damage to the land and any neighbouring land owned by SOPA as a result of the Licensee carrying out the works;
- if necessary, works associated with the preparation of any plans, surveys, as-built drawings, subdivision plans and other documents which are required to be completed; and
- the exercise of rights under appropriate legislation.

Term of the proposed licences

2 years with one option of 2 years, commencing upon conclusion of the submission period (subject to the receipt of any submissions)
