MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007
Section 109
Declaration of mental health facility

I, DR BRENDAN FLYNN, Executive Director, Mental Health Branch, acting under delegation from the Secretary, NSW Ministry of Health, and pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007* and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, DO HEREBY:

(a) REVOKE the Order published in the NSW Government Gazette No 555 of 29 October 2021, declaring certain premises of the Princes of Wales Hospital to be a mental health facility in accordance with section 109 of the Mental Health Act 2007; and

(b) DECLARE the following premises of **The Prince of Wales Hospital, Barker Street, Randwick NSW 2031** to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:

- **Kiloh Mental Health Unit**, located in Building 25, the Kiloh Centre;
- **Euroa Older Persons Mental Health Unit**, located on the southern side of the ground floor of Building 11, the Euroa Centre;
- **Prince of Wales Mental Health Rehabilitation Unit**, located on the northern side of the ground floor of Building 11, the Euroa Centre;
- **Prince of Wales Psychiatric Emergency Care Centre**, located on level B2 of the Acute Services Building, 8 Magill Street;
- **Prince of Wales Mental Health Intensive Care Unit**, located in Building 19; and

(c) DECLARE this facility to be designated in the class of facilities known as “mental health assessment and inpatient treatment” class.
