REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Between Milsons Point and Beulah Street Wharf, Port Jackson

Duration

12:15pm – 1:00pm – Sunday 23 July 2023

Detail

A special event will take place on Sydney Harbour at the above location. The event will involve Australian Defence Force Red Berets parachuting from an aircraft into the water.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be patrolled by Maritime vessels and other official control vessels. The Exclusion Zone will be established in a 200m diameter between Milsons Point and Beulah Street Wharf (as per the attached map).

The activation and deactivation of the Exclusion Zone will be announced on VHF 13.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

Detail

A surf life saving event involving inshore rescue boats will be conducted on waters adjacent to Cudgen Beach, approximately 200 metres offshore and 200 metres along the beach.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by the presence of buoys.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Clarence River, Maclean, adjacent to McNaughton Park

Duration

9:00am to 4:00pm – Sunday 23 July 2023

Detail

Powerboat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Clarence River, as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – *Marine Safety Act 1998*).
