REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

- Tweed River – between Stotts Island and Condong Bridge (Saturday 5 August 2023)
- Tweed River – Fingal Head to Murwillumbah (Sunday 6 August 2023)

Duration

- 12.00pm to 4.00pm – Saturday 5 August 2023
- 8.30am to 2.00pm – Sunday 6 August 2023

Detail

Competitive water ski races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Tweed River at the locations and times specified above, involving the use of high-speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using towlines, and persons in the water from time to time presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be indicated by the presence of support vessels along the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Bennelong Point, Port Jackson

Duration

8:50pm to 9:15pm – Wednesday 9 August 2023

Detail

A fireworks display will be conducted northeast of Bennelong Point, Sydney Harbour (as per the attached map). Fireworks will be launched from a barge anchored at the location.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, 125m around the fireworks barge and approximately 200 meters northeast from Bennelong Point. The Exclusion Zone will be patrolled and indicated by Maritime patrol vessels.

The activation and deactivation of the Exclusion Zone will be announced on VHF 13. In the event of inclement weather, the Exclusion Zone may not be activated.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

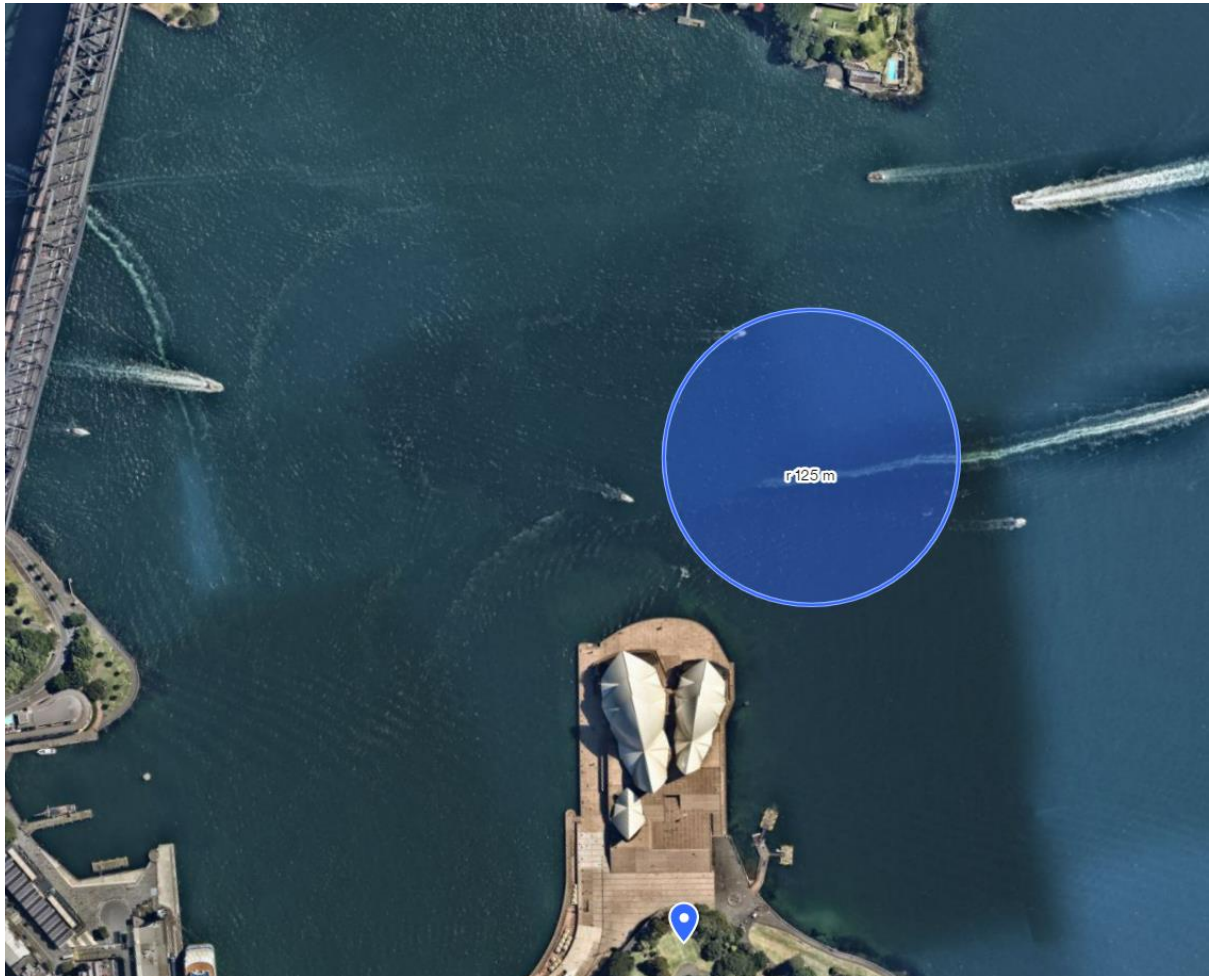

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

Duration

- 8:00am to 5:30pm – Saturday 5 August 2023
- 8:00am to 5:30pm – Sunday 6 August 2023

Detail

Power Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert as specified above. The event will involve the use of high-speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be monitored by event staff and support vessels.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
