Notice of public exhibition of draft amending plan to the Kosciuszko National Park Wild Horse Heritage Management Plan 2021

A draft amending plan to the Kosciuszko National Park Wild Horse Heritage Management Plan 2021 (the Plan) is on public exhibition. The draft amending plan proposes to authorise the use of aerial shooting as one of the available control methods in the Plan, alongside existing control methods, together with ancillary, supporting amendments.
