REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Manning River, Taree - adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree between the Martin Bridge & the Manning River Rowing Club building at Endeavour Place boat ramp.

Duration

7.00am to 4.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 16 September 2023
- Sunday 17 September 2023

Detail

Dragon Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Manning River, Taree as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified for the location between the above times and will consist of a course between the Martin Bridge and the Manning River Rowing Club. The Zone will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit Lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a transit lane.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).

Lower Myall River – entire width of the river from Myall Street Bridge (adjacent Tea Gardens) to Tamboy village.

Detail

Competitive paddle craft events will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Lower Myall River as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be monitored by control vessels stationed around the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Special Restrictions


Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

 - (ii) a card known as a gold repatriation health card that is embossed with TPI, EDA, WAR WIDOW or WAR WIDOWER,
Note. TPI refers to totally and permanently incapacitated and EDA refers to extreme disablement adjustment.
 - (iii) a card prescribed by the regulations as being equivalent to any of those cards, or
- (b) who is entitled to receive, in respect of any injury or disease, a pension, or other amount, approved by Transport for NSW that is payable under the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth or the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* of the Commonwealth, or
- (c) who is a war widow or war widower (within the meaning of section 5E of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth), or
- (d) who is under 16 years of age and named as a dependant on the current New South Wales Pensioner Concession Card in (a) above, or
- (e) who is under 16 years of age and holds a current New South Wales Centrelink Health Care Card.
