## ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013

### ORDER

#### *Section 45*

I, Simon Brodie, Senior Manager Licence Operations, a delegate of Transport for NSW, pursuant to section 45 of the *Road Transport Act 2013*, by this Order, approve the type of interlock device specified below as an *approved interlock device*:

#### **Type of device:**

The interlock device Dräger Interlock 7500 (also known as Interlock 7500) and the interlock device Dräger Interlock 7500 (also known as Interlock 7500) with Dräger Interlock 7000 camera installed as a component of the device.

#### **Explanatory Note:**

Section 45 of the *Road Transport Act 2013*, provides that a type of 'approved interlock device' (designed to analyse a breath sample for the presence of alcohol and prevent a motor vehicle from being started if it detects more than a certain concentration of alcohol) requires approval by Transport for NSW by order published in the Gazette.

This Order specifies the Dräger Interlock 7500 - and the Dräger Interlock 7500 with Dräger Interlock 7000 camera installed as a component of the device - as a type of '*approved interlock device*'.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Tomaga River – Entire width of the river between the entrance to the estuary at Mossy Point, where the Tomaga River meets the Tasman Sea, upstream for approximately 2.5 kilometres to the Tomakin Bridge.

**Duration**

9.00am to 12.00pm – Saturday 3 February 2024

**Detail**

The swim leg of various triathlon races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Tomaga River as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be indicated by the presence of large inflatable buoys and monitored and maintained by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.
