## VEXATIOUS PROCEEDINGS ACT 2008

### Notification of Orders Concerning Vexatious Litigant

Md Rajibul Islam

On 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024, His Honour Justice Parker made the following Orders in Supreme Court of NSW case **2023/451306 Toyota Finance Australia v Md Rajibul Islam**:

(1) An order pursuant to section 8(1) of the *Vexatious Proceedings Act* 2008 (NSW) that the defendant (by himself, or by his servants or agents, or by any corporation controlled by him) is prohibited from instituting any proceedings in New South Wales, including by filing any application, interlocutory process, or notice of motion in any existing proceedings in New South Wales, either in his own name or in the name of any other person, against:

- (a) Toyota Finance Australia Limited ACN 002 435 181 (TFAL);
- (b) McCarroll's of Moss Vale Pty Ltd ACN 003 411 210 (McCarrolls);
- (c) any business name used by either TFAL or McCarrolls;
- (d) any employee or contractor of TFAL or McCarrolls;
- (e) Jo Mae Purvis;
- (f) David Matthew Farrar; or
- (g) Farrar Lawyers Pty Limited;

relating to or in any way connected with:

- (a) any finance contract entered into between:
  - (A) TFAL;
  - (B) Australian Real Estate Relation Pty Limited (ARER); and/or
  - (C) the defendant;
- (b) a 2021 Maserati Ghibli with registration number DGG96U with vehicle identification number ZAMXS57DOO1373250 (Vehicle);
- (c) the repossession or any dealing with the Vehicle; or
- (d) the winding up of ARER,

without first obtaining leave of this Court.

(2) An order that the defendant pay the plaintiff's costs of these proceedings on an indemnity basis.
