I, Dr Kerry Chant, Chief Health Officer, a duly appointed delegate of the Secretary, NSW Health, pursuant to s 84(1) of the Voluntary Assisted Dying Act 2022 (NSW) (VAD Act) and section 26 of the Interpretation Act 1987 (NSW), hereby:
