Each notice in the Government Gazette has a unique reference number that appears in parentheses at the end of each page of the notice and can be used as a reference for that notice. For example, [NSWGG-2024-10-1].


The Gazette is compiled by the Parliamentary Counsel's Office and published on the NSW Government Gazette website (www.gazette.legislation.nsw.gov.au) under the authority of the NSW Government. The website contains a permanent archive of past Gazettes.

ERRATUM

IN the notice reserving Burragorang State Recreation Area published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 176, folio 10538 dated 13 December 1991 and the subsequent erratum published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 36, folio 1784 dated 13 March 1992, the description for the symbol  on the diagram is replaced with ‘BOUNDARY OF STATE RECREATION AREA IS TOP WATER LEVEL (116.72m) BETWEEN THE POINTS SHOWN THUS:’

IN the notice reserving Nattai State Recreation Area published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 176, folio 10542 dated 13 December 1991, the description for the symbol  on the diagram is replaced with ‘BOUNDARY OF STATE RECREATION AREA IS TOP WATER LEVEL (116.72m) BETWEEN THE POINTS SHOWN THUS:’

IN the notice reserving Yerranderie State Recreation Area published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 176, folio 10536 dated 13 December 1991, the description for the note on the diagram is replaced with ‘NOTE: BOUNDARY OF YERRANDERIE STATE RECREATION AREA EXTENDING ALONG WOLLONDILLY RIVER AND LAKE BURRAGORANG IS R.L.116.72m.’

IN the notice reserving Nattai National Park published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 176, folios 10531 & 10532 dated 13 December 1991, the description on folio 10532, at line 20 in the schedule, ‘the eastern bank of Lake Burragorang, (RL.117m)’ is replaced with ‘the eastern bank of Lake Burragorang, (RL.116.72m)’ and at line 25 in the schedule, ‘to the top water level of Lake Burragorang (RL.117m)’ is replaced with ‘to the top water level of Lake Burragorang (116.72m)’
