# ORDER

#### Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008,* the Order that took effect on and from **26 July 2021** served on **Mr Jake William Heatherington (PHA0001614358)** of Malua Bay NSW 2536, prohibiting him as a pharmacist from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture or extract of a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 6 November 2024.

### Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* a direction has been issued that the Order that took effect on and from 1 March 2024, on **Dr George Jim Leslie Jacobs (MED0001065560)** of Bondi Junction NSW 2022, prohibiting him as a medical practitioner, from supplying, having possession of or issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101 and 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 8 November 2024.
