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**POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS REGULATION 2008**

Supply of Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 Substances  
Supply of Schedule 4 Substances

I, DAVID NG, Chief Pharmacist, a duly appointed delegate of the Secretary, NSW Health, make this instrument pursuant to clauses 170 and 171 of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW) [the Regulation] for the purpose of clauses 17 and 53 of the Regulation. Pursuant to clause 171(1) of the Regulation, the authorisation is granted subject to conditions.

**Authorisation to Supply Schedule 2, Schedule 3 and Restricted Substances**

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**1 Application**

This instrument authorises the class of person to supply Schedule 2 substances, Schedule 3 substances and restricted substances as listed in section 2.

**2 Authorised Class of Person**

A **registered nurse** employed or engaged by the Ambulance Service of New South Wales as a 'flight nurse'.

### 3 Definitions

In this instrument:

- *Restricted substance* means a substance specified in Schedule 4 of the Poisons List.

### 4 Conditions

- a. The storage of Schedule 2 substances, Schedule 3 substances, and restricted substances shall be in accordance with clause 29 of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW); and
- b. The recording of the supply of Schedule 2 substances, Schedule 3 substances, and restricted substances shall be in accordance with clause 38 of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW); and
- c. The labelling of Schedule 2 substances, Schedule 3 substances, and restricted substances shall be in accordance with Appendix A of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* (NSW).

### 5 Validity

This Authority commences on the day it is signed and dated, and expires on **1 February 2026**, or otherwise on a date that this Authority is varied, replaced or revoked.
