EXEMPTION ORDER

- 1 In this Exemption Order:
- (a) **Act** means the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW)
 - (b) **Applicant** means Linfox Australia Pty Ltd
 - (c) **Conditions of Contract** means conditions of the 2013 Contract between the Applicant and the Commonwealth of Australia, including where that contract is extended, amended or replaced, for the provision of the Services.
 - (d) **Defence Materials** means any materials or information in relation to which access or use is regulated by the Security Requirements.
 - (e) **Security Requirements** means the Applicant's security requirements under and pursuant to:
 - (i) Conditions of Contract;
 - (ii) any other contract with the Commonwealth of Australia, Australian Defence Force or United States Government (including any military departments) to which the Applicant is, or during the term of the Exemption Order becomes, a direct contractor or subcontractor, and which contain security clearance and related requirements which are the same or substantially similar to the Conditions of Contract. For the avoidance of doubt, any security clearance or related requirement which is not the same or substantially similar to the Conditions of Contract does not fall within this definition of Security Requirements and is therefore not covered by this Exemption Order;
 - (iii) Applicant's Third Party Re-Transfer authorisation;
 - (iv) US Export Regulations;
 - (v) Manufacturing licence agreements;
 - (vi) Technical assistance agreements;
 - (vii) Proprietary information agreements; and

(viii) Export licenses granted by the United States Department of Commerce and/or the United States State Department.

(f) **Services** means the warehousing, disposal, distribution, information technology, logistics and supply chain solutions and services which the Applicant has been engaged to provide, either directly as a contractor or indirectly as a subcontractor, to the Commonwealth of Australia, the Australian Defence Force and/or the United States Government (including any military departments), to which the Security Requirements apply.

(g) **US Export Regulations** means the requirements of the International Traffic In Arms Regulations (22 CFR (US) §§120-130) and the Export Administration Regulations (15 CFR (US) §§730-774) or other regulation to similar effect, as amended or replaced from time to time, so far as they apply to Defence Materials used in the Applicant's operations.

(h) **Workforce** means the Applicant's employees, contractors, contract workers who are engaged to participate in the provision of the Services in New South Wales.

2 Under the provisions of section 126 of the Act but for the purposes only of meeting the Security Requirements, the Applicant is granted an exemption from the provisions of sections 8, 10, 51 and 52 of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the Applicant to do the following:

(a) ask present and prospective members of the Workforce to disclose their full names;

(b) ask present and prospective members of the Workforce to declare their exact citizenship (including any dual citizenship);

(c) require present and prospective members of the Workforce to produce a photocopy of their passport(s);

(d) require present and prospective members of the Workforce, to notify the Applicant of any change to their citizenship status, to the best of their knowledge and belief;

(e) record and maintain a register (**Register**) of those members of the Workforce that are permitted to access Defence Materials or any facilities owned or controlled by the Australian Defence Force, the United States Government (including any military departments), or the Applicant or another contractor of the Australian Defence Force or the United States Government (including any military departments), or to be involved in the provision of the Services due to citizenship, with access to the Register limited to only those members of the Workforce with a need to know;

(f) require members of the Workforce to wear a badge confirming their right to access Defence Materials or their level of access to any Defence Materials or their right or the extent of their right to participate in the provision of the Services. Such badges may be coded but not in such a way as to identify:

(i) the citizenship of the person (including dual citizenship), as declared;
or

- (ii) the reasons for that person's level of access;
- (g) restrict:
 - (i) involvement in the provision of the Services; and
 - (ii) access to Defence Materials;

to particular members of the Workforce, based on their citizenship, by means of transfer if necessary;
- (h) restrict access to areas of its facilities connected with the provision of the Services to particular members of the Workforce, based on their citizenship;
- (i) advertise positions with the Applicant which involve the provision of the Services or access to the Defence Materials as being open only to anyone who can obtain the necessary security clearances, with specific reference to this Exemption Order;
- (j) reject applications from prospective members of the Workforce for positions involving the provision of the Services or requiring access to the Defence Materials, based on the prospective Workforce member's citizenship as declared, but not on the basis of their country of birth, descent, ethnic or ethno-religious or national origin, or substantive contacts with other countries;
- (k) enter into agreements with or obtain undertakings from the Applicant's suppliers, contractors, employees, contract workers, agents and consultants pursuant to which those third parties undertake to comply with the Security Requirements, and to take all practicable steps to assist the Applicant in complying with the Security Requirements.

3 This Exemption Order does not extend to any other identification, collection, storage or use of information in relation to any Workforce member in respect of that Workforce member's race, colour, nationality, descent or ethnic, ethno-religious or national origin.

4 Except to the extent expressly provided herein, this Exemption Order does not excuse, or purport to excuse, the Applicant from complying with its obligations pursuant to the Act, any other legislation or at common law.

5 The Applicant is required, prior to taking any action permitted by this Exemption Order, to provide all current and prospective members of the Workforce with:

- (a) express notice that they may be adversely affected by this exemption if they are not an Australian citizen or if they hold dual citizenship;
- (b) a reasonable explanation in plain English of the nature of any adverse effects of such action to them; and
- (c) information (at the time of recruitment in the case of prospective members of the Workforce) about how they can apply for Australian citizenship.

6 In addition to the above conditions the Applicant is required to:

- (a) produce comprehensive anti-discrimination policies governing all aspects of the work and Workforce, including management, and with particular regard to race discrimination, vilification and harassment and victimisation;
- (b) establish concise and comprehensive dispute resolution and grievance procedures to receive, investigate and resolve discrimination complaints and grievances and, in particular, those relating to race discrimination, vilification and harassment and victimisation;
- (c) implement training programs, including at induction, to ensure that all members of the Workforce, including management, are fully informed of their rights and obligations under such policies and procedures particularly with regard to issues of race discrimination, vilification, harassment and victimisation;
- (d) ensure that all members of the Workforce, including management, receive regular education and training in issues of discrimination, particularly race discrimination, vilification, harassment and victimisation;
- (e) take steps to fully inform the Workforce, including management, of their rights under the Act and, in particular (but not limited to) the complaints procedure under the Act and to ensure that all members of the Workforce, including management, are aware of the rights of aggrieved persons to take their complaints to Anti-Discrimination NSW and through the New South Wales Civil and Administrative Tribunal;
- (f) take steps to fully inform the Workforce, including management, of the requirements of, and their rights and obligations under, the *Racial Discrimination Act 1975* (Cth);
- (g) notify Anti-Discrimination NSW if the discriminatory aspects of the relevant Security Requirements are substantially amended, repealed or become inoperative, in whole or in part, so that this Exemption Order may be revoked or amended.

7 The Applicant is required to advise Anti-Discrimination NSW by 31 January (for the reporting period 1 July to 31 December) and 31 July (for the reporting period 1 January to 30 June) of every year over the period specified in the order, of:

- (a) the steps it has taken to comply with all the above conditions, including:
 - (i) the number of job applicants rejected for the purposes of the Security Requirements, including those subsequently appointed to other roles within each reporting period;
 - (ii) the number of employees retrenched or redeployed due the Security Requirements and any steps taken to minimise retrenchment or redeployment, and any steps taken generally to mitigate the impact of the Applicant's responsibility under the Security Requirements on the deployment of its workforce within each reporting period;
 - (iii) the number of vacancies advertised within each reporting period, including the number of such vacancies where candidates were required to satisfy the Security Requirements.

- (b) the implementation of and compliance generally with the terms of this Exemption Order.
- 8 The Applicant is required to take all reasonable steps to ensure that any employees adversely affected by this Exemption Order, retain employment with the Applicant, and do not suffer a reduction in wages, salary or opportunity for advancement.
- 9 If the Applicant, in order to enable it to comply with the Security Requirements, moves a member of the Workforce from one project to another, the Applicant must take reasonable steps both to explain to that person why the transfer has occurred and to avoid any race-based hostility that might result from the transfer.
- 10 Where prospective employees adversely affected by this Exemption Order would otherwise have been acceptable to the Applicant as employees, the Applicant is required to consider and, if feasible, implement reasonable and practicable alternatives to rejection, such as employment in other work (whether with the Applicant or one of its associated entities) or obtaining the necessary approvals under the Security Requirements.

This Exemption is granted for a period of 5 years.

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW), the exemption order granted to Essential Energy on 19 May 2022 is HEREBY VARIED to read:

Under the provisions of section 126 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW), an exemption is given from sections 8 and 51 of the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW) to Essential Energy to advertise, designate and recruit positions for First Nations people only, including up to 10% of Early Talent Pathway positions each year, in pursuit of a 6% Indigenous workforce participation rate.

This exemption will remain in force until 18 May 2032.


