This exemption will remain in force until 20 April 2033.

## Home Building Act 1989 (NSW)

### Qualification requirements for an endorsed contractor licence or qualified supervisor certificate for general building work

I, Graeme Head, Secretary, Department of Customer Service, as the “Secretary” under the *Home Building Act 1989 (NSW)* (“the Act”) determine

1. pursuant to section 20(2) of the Act, the qualifications and experience or additional standards or other requirements required to be held or met by the applicant for an endorsed contractor license; and
2. pursuant to section 25(2) of the Act, the qualifications and experience, or additional standards or other requirements, required to be held or met by an applicant for a qualified supervisor or tradesperson certificate

to be as follows:

- (a) where the application is received by the Secretary on or after the date on which this Instrument is signed (“the Commencement Date”):
  - (i) the possession of qualifications or the passing of examinations specified in Column 1 of Table A to Schedule 1; and
  - (ii) the possession of experience specified in Column 2 of Table A opposite the relevant matter in Column 1;
- (b) where the application is received by the Secretary before the Commencement Date of this Instrument:
  - (a) the possession of qualifications or the passing of examinations; and
  - (b) the possession of experience,specified in the Instrument dealing with the same matters as this Instrument which was immediately in force at the time the relevant application was made.

## Explanatory note

As at the date of this Instrument, the Secretary, Department of Customer Service is the 'Secretary' under the Act. See the definition of "Secretary" in clause 1(1) of Schedule 1 of the Act.

## Interpretation

In this Instrument:

**"the Act"** means the Home Building Act 1989 (NSW);

**"Australian University"** has the same meaning as in the Higher Education Act 2001 (NSW) or successor legislation in force for the time being providing for the recognition of Australian universities;

references to **"Certificate"** and **"Licence"** are respectively to a qualified supervisor certificate, or endorsed contractor licence, as defined in the Act to do, or supervise general building work;

**"Degree"** means a degree of any kind, and in particular includes the degrees of doctor, master and bachelor but excludes an associate degree or honorary degree;

reference to a **"Diploma"** in Item 8 in Table D of Schedule 1, does not include a Diploma of: Building; Construction; Construction Management; Construction Economics; Applied Science (Building); Structural Engineering; or Quantity Surveying. On every other occasion the term "Diploma" is used in this Instrument it is to be given its ordinary meaning;

**"Experience"** means experience gained by the applicant as:

- (a) an employee of; or
- (b) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate and as a nominated supervisor for the contractor licence held by; or
- (c) a holder of an endorsed contractor licence contracted to; or
- (d) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate in the capacity of a nominated supervisor for a contractor licence held by an individual, partnership or corporation contracted to; or

the holder of a contractor licence authorising the holder to do the class of residential building work in which the experience was gained ("the Work"), where the applicant, during the relevant period, was:

supervised and directed in the doing of the Work by the holder of an endorsed contractor licence or qualified supervisor certificate authorising its holder to supervise the Work, and this is verified in the Relevant Application Form; and  
received Remuneration in accordance with law for the Work which the applicant carried out; or

- (e) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate in the category of full general building work or an endorsed contractor licence in the category of full general building work, held continuously for a minimum period of 2 years within 10 years from the date the application is made;

**“NSW Website”** means either the NSW Fair Trading website or the Building Commission NSW website where the Relevant Application Form is or will be published.

**“Relevant Application Form”** means the relevant application form for the Licence or Certificate that is being applied for, which is or will be published on the NSW Website, including the required attachments to that form. (Note – Applications are to be made in accordance with section 12 of the Licensing and Registration (Uniform Procedures) Act 2002);

**“Registered Training Organisation”** has the same meaning as in the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011 (Cth);

**“Residential building work”** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 Clause 2 of the Act.

reference to **“Schedule 1”** includes the tables under Schedule 1 of this Instrument;

**“TAFE”** means the New South Wales Technical and Further Education Commission.

**“Remuneration”** means wages, salary and director’s fees paid to an applicant under a contract of employment and/or under a federal or state industrial agreement to provide services under which the person is employed on a regular basis but does not include bonuses, commissions, allowances or any other ad-hoc payments, including payments from a profit-sharing arrangement between the applicant and any another party, where such payments are the only payments made to the applicant for the work which the applicant carried out.

## **Public Notaries Appointment Amendment (Miscellaneous) Rule 2024**

under the

Public Notaries Act 1997

The Legal Profession Admission Board made the following rule under the Public Notaries Act 1997 on 8 October 2024.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this rule is to amend the Public Notaries Appointment Rules to reflect the definitions contained in the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW), to prescribe deadlines for making applications, and to make minor amendments that would assist with legibility.

#### **1 Name of Rule**

This Rule is the Public Notaries Appointment Amendment (Miscellaneous) Rule 2024

#### **2 Commencement**

This Rule commences on 29 November 2024 and is required to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

#### **3 Amendment of Public Notaries Appointment Rules**

(1) Rule 1

Omit the Rule. Insert instead:

##### **1 Definitions**

In these Rules, unless the context or subject matter otherwise indicate or so require:

"Australian practising certificate" has the same meaning as in the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)

"Board" means the Legal Profession Admission Board.

"Court" means the Supreme Court of New South Wales.

"Executive Officer" means the person appointed as Executive Officer to the Board.

"Australian lawyer" has the same meaning as in the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)

"Prescribed Fee" means the fee fixed from time to time by the Board.

"Public Notary" means a person appointed and enrolled as a Public Notary appointed or deemed to have been appointed under the *Public Notaries Act 1985* or under section 6 of the *Public Notaries Act 1997*.

"Rules" means rules of the Court.

"Society of Notaries" means the Society of Notaries of New South Wales Incorporated.

Note: "Barrister", "legal practitioner" and "Solicitor" are defined in section 3 of the Public Notaries Act 1997.

(2) Rule 2

Omit the Rule. Insert instead:

## 2 Qualifications for appointment

A person is qualified for approval as a suitable candidate for appointment as a Public Notary if he or she:

- (a) has been a legal practitioner for a continuous period of not less than five years,
- (b) is the holder of a current Australian practising certificate, and
- (c) has completed a Notarial Practice Course conducted by the Board or approved by the Board.

Note: "legal practitioner" is defined in section 3 of the Public Notaries Act 1997.

(3) Rule 3

Amend the Rule by adding the heading "**Exemptions**" next to the number "3".

(4) Rule 4

Omit the Rule. Insert instead:

## 4 Evidence in support

An applicant for approval shall produce to the Board evidence as to his or her suitability for appointment. Such evidence shall include:

- (a) evidence of admission as an Australian lawyer,

- (b) evidence that the applicant has held an Australian practising certificate for a total of not less than 5 years continuously,
- (c) evidence that the applicant is the holder of a current Australian practising certificate,
- (d) evidence that the applicant has completed a course prescribed by Rule 2 (c), and
- (e) such evidence of professional experience as is considered by the applicant relevant to the application.

(5) Rule 5

Omit the Rule. Insert instead:

#### 5. **Manner of Application**

(1) Every person applying for approval as a suitable candidate for appointment as a Public Notary shall lodge with the registrar:

- (a) an application in or to the effect of Form 1;
- (b) documentation to support the requirements of Rule 4 (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e);
- (c) a certificate in Form 157 of the Rules that the oath of office was duly tendered and taken before a registrar of the Court; and
- (d) the prescribed fee.

(2) A copy of the application, but without supporting documents, shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the Society of Notaries.

(3) The registrar shall publish on the Board's website the dates on which the Board will consider any application lodged, and the deadline for the lodging of any application for that meeting.

(4) The Board shall not consider any application lodged after the deadline for a meeting unless the prescribed late fee has been paid.

(6) Rule 6

(7) Rule 9

Amend the Rule by adding the heading "**Maintenance of the Roll**" in bold next to the number "9".
