ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2013 – ORDER

The Honorable Margaret Beazley AC KC, Governor.

I, the Honorable Margaret Beazley AC KC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and pursuant to the *Road Transport Act 2013* (the Act), do, by this Order, approve the type of traffic enforcement device named in Schedule 1 as being designed for the use of **average speed imaging**, by photographing a vehicle at a point during its journey between different points on a road for use in calculating the vehicle's average speed between those points in accordance with the terms of section 134(1)(c) of the Act.

The average speed imaging device, **Vector 3**

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Edward River – near the Deniliquin Boat Club on Riverview Drive, Deniliquin as follows:

- Upstream 400 metres of the Deniliquin Boat Club and adjacent to the land-based feature of the Big 4 Deniliquin Holiday Park, to
- Downstream 400 metres of the Deniliquin Boat Club and adjacent to the land-based feature of the Warbreccan Homestead.

Duration

7:00am to 7:00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 17 February 2024
- Sunday 18 February 2024

Detail

A wakeboarding competition will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Edward River as specified above. The event will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified at the above location while the events are in progress, and will be marked by buoys, monitored by control vessels and patrolled by Maritime vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

Nelson Bay – between Nelson Head and Red Patch Point, Port Stephens.

Duration

7.00am to 8.00am – Friday 23 February 2024.

Detail

A sail past of game fishing vessels will be conducted on the navigable waters of Nelson Bay as specified above, and may present a significant hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by control vessels stationed on the perimeter.


Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Regulated Area

Sydney Harbour – from Kirribilli Point to Laings Point, Watsons Bay, comprising all navigable waters bounded by imaginary lines drawn between:

- Garden Island to Robertson Point, Cremorne; and
- Georges Head, Mosman to Laings Point, Vaucluse

Duration

- 12.00pm to 3.00pm – Friday 23 February 2024
- 3.00pm to 6.00pm – Saturday 24 and Sunday 25 February 2024

Detail

A Sail GP will take place on Sydney Harbour at the above location. To ensure the safety of navigation, **Regulated Areas** comprising specified navigation channels will be established.

Up to 25 yellow buoys will be laid approximately 150 metres from the shoreline on the western side of the harbour in the vicinity of Chowder Head to Bradleys Head to mark a navigation channel between the Exclusion Zone and the shore.

Up to 26 lit yellow buoys will be laid approximately 150 metres from the shoreline on the eastern side of the harbour in the vicinity of Vaucluse Point to Queens Beach Vaucluse and Point Piper to mark a navigation channel between the Exclusion Zone and the shore.

Exclusion Zone 1

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** will be specified during the event, which will be marked by yellow and orange buoys within which race marking buoys will also be placed (see the attached map). The Zone will be monitored by Police, Maritime and other official control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, vessels operating in the Regulated Area:

- must not stop or drift in navigation channels or produce excessive wash;

- must proceed to (or depart from) the designated spectator areas when using the channels; and
- must comply with a 6-knot maximum speed and no wash restriction within 200 metres of the Exclusion Zone when activated.
- No anchoring in the enclosed area from a line between Woollahra Point to South of Queens Beach to Rose Bay Wharf, Port Jackson.

Exclusion Zone 2

A second exclusion zone will be established on Port Jackson between Waterfront Park and Glebe Island in Johnstons Bay, around the 9 swing mooring buoys (as per the attached diagram) from 9:00am on Thursday 22 February 2024 until 8:00pm on Monday 26 February 2024.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – *Marine Safety Act 1998*).
