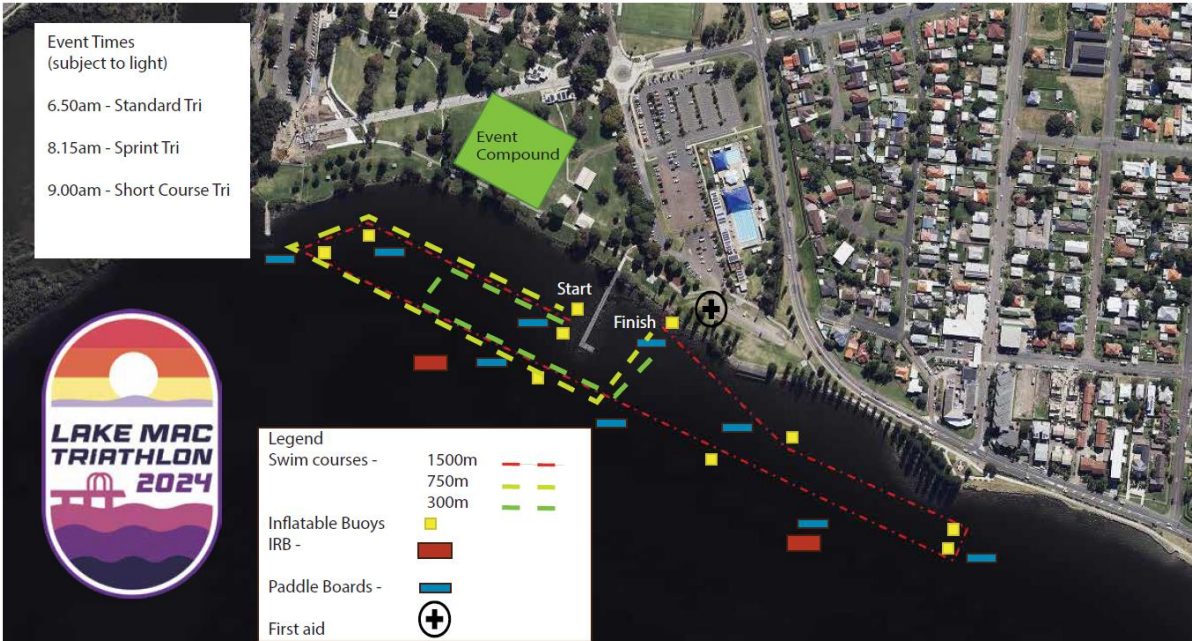

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Hawkesbury River – Windsor Reach, between Windsor Bridge and the furthest downstream end of Windsor Reach.

Duration

9:00am to 5:00pm on the following dates:

- Sunday 10 March 2024
- Sunday 7 April 2024
- Sunday 7 July 2024
- Sunday 11 August 2024

Detail

Power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Hawkesbury River as specified above (see the attached map). A number of high-speed power vessels will be active in the area during the above times, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.
