## Part 1 Preliminary

### 1 Name of Order

This order is the *Fisheries Management (Sharks taken in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery Possession Limit) Order 2024*.

### 2 Commencement and duration

This Order commences on publication and will remain in force for five years.

### 3 Definitions

(1) In this order:

**demersal fish trap endorsement** has the same meaning as in clause 5 of the Appendix to the *Fisheries Management (Ocean Trap and Line Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006*.

**endorsement holder** means the holder of a line fishing western zone endorsement, line fishing eastern zone endorsement or a demersal fish trap endorsement.

**line fishing eastern zone endorsement** has the same meaning as in clause 5 of the Appendix to the *Fisheries Management (Ocean Trap and Line Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006*.

**line fishing western zone endorsement** has the same meaning as in clause 5 of the Appendix to the *Fisheries Management (Ocean Trap and Line Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006*.

**Ocean Trap and Line Fishery** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Act.

**possession** has the same meaning as in section 4 of the Act.

**processed** means headed, gutted, or headed and gutted.

**shark** means the species of cartilaginous fishes contained within the families in Column 1 and Column 2 of the following table excluding the species in Column 3:

## **Part 2 Possession Limit**

### **4 Possession Limit**

- (1) At any time, an endorsement holder in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery must not have possession of more than:
- (a) 750 kilograms of shark comprised of any single species or a combination of species if the sharks are whole, or
  - (b) 500 kilograms of shark comprised of any single species or a combination of species if any of the sharks are processed.
- (2) This possession limit applies when the endorsement holder is in or on or adjacent to any waters or is transporting or storing the fish.

#### **Notes:**

1. Possession of a thing includes having the thing under control at any place, even though some other person has physical possession of the thing (section 4, *the Act*).
2. This order is made in conjunction with the *Fisheries Management (Sharks taken in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery Fishing Closure) Notification 2024*.

- (2) In this closure, a reference to the common name of a species of fish does not limit the scientific description of that species of fish. If there is any inconsistency between the common name and the scientific description of the species, the scientific description of the species prevails.

## Part 2 Fishing closure

### 4 Fishing closure

In any weekly period commencing midnight Sunday and ending on midnight the following Sunday, an endorsement holder in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery is prohibited from taking more than:

- (a) 750 kilograms of shark comprised of any single species or a combination of species if the sharks are whole, or
- (b) 500 kilograms of shark comprised of any single species or a combination of species if any of the sharks are processed.

#### Notes:

1. If processing a shark, other than Gulper sharks (family: CENTROPHORIDAE), Dogfishes (family: SQUALIDAE) or Catsharks (family: SCYLORHINIDAE):
  - (a) the head and gills should be removed by a cut in front of the last gill slit and pectoral fin with the cut being perpendicular to the long axis of the fish, and
  - (b) the belly flaps must not be removed (refer section 20B of the Act and clause 90 of the Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2019).
2. This fishing closure is made in conjunction with the *Fisheries Management (Sharks taken in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery Possession Limit) Order 2024*.

### 1. Name of Notice

This notice is the *Notice of requirements for non-metallic ventilation and belt conveyor components to be FRAS 2024*.

### 2. Commencement

This notice commences on the day it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

### 3. Interpretation

In this notice:

***Belt conveyor accessories*** means accessories typically in contact with the conveyor belt which are in small quantities. Examples include scraper blades, ploughs, skirt rubbers, slider impact bars, pulley lagging, component parts of belt tracking systems, belt splicing kits and belt repair kits.

***Ventilation components*** means ventilation appliances and accessories (such as venturi blowers and auxiliary fans), ventilation sheet (including brattice), ventilation ducting (both rigid and flexible) and ventilation ducting joining bands.

### 4. Revocation

The notice *FIRE RESISTANT ANTI-STATIC MATERIAL FOR USE IN UNDERGROUND COAL MINES AND RECLAIM TUNNELS IN COAL MINES NOTICE* published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 6 of 13 January 2023 is revoked.

### 5. The applicable items of plant

This notice applies to the following items of plant:
