#### POISONS AND THERAPEUTIC GOODS REGULATION 2008

#### ORDER

#### Withdrawal of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Dr Paul Placanica (MED0001623769)**, of MASCOT NSW 2020, prohibiting him until further notice, as a medical practitioner, from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation.

This Order is to take effect on and from 12 August 2024.

#### ORDER

#### Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* a direction has been issued that the Order that took effect on and from 29 July 2022, on **Dr Adrian Teong Lye Lim (MED0001173691)** of Campbelltown NSW 2560, prohibiting him as a medical practitioner, from supplying, having possession of or issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101 and 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 12 August 2024.
