ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO

Legislative Council Office Sydney 15 August 2024

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor has, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, this day assented to the undermentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 50, 2024 – An Act to amend the *Rice Marketing Act 1983* to provide for the partial and complete end to rice vesting arrangements; and for other purposes. [**Rice Marketing Amendment Bill 2024**]

Act No. 51, 2024 – An Act to amend the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979* to improve transparency in animal welfare enforcement activities; to provide for matters for certain convicted persons; and for related purposes. [**Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Amendment (Transparency and Fit and Proper Persons) Bill 2024**]
