## Legislative Council Office Sydney 20 August 2024

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor has, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, this day assented to the undermentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 52, 2024 – An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to the *Ombudsman Act 1974* and the *Community Services (Complaints, Reviews and Monitoring) Act 1993*; and to repeal the Ombudsman Regulation 2016. [Ombudsman and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2024]

Act No. 53, 2024 – An Act to amend various Acts and regulations administered by the Minister for Customer Service and Digital Government, the Minister for Better Regulation and Fair Trading and the Minister for Building. [Better Regulation Legislation Amendment (Miscellaneous) Bill 2024]

## ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, 20 August 2024

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 54 — An Act to amend the *NSW Self Insurance Corporation Act 2004* to establish a scheme of insurance for certain persons providing out-of-home care services and youth homelessness services to cover liabilities arising from physical or sexual abuse of a person; and for other purposes. [NSW Self Insurance Corporation Amendment (Special Liability Insurance) Bill 2024]

Act No. 55 — An Act to amend the *Retail Trading Act 2008* to restrict trading hours on Anzac Day. [Retail Trading Amendment (Anzac Day Trading Hours) Bill 2024]

Act No. 56 — An Act to amend the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* in relation to an administration scheme for a particular employee organisation; and for the appointment of an administrator for the administration of the employee organisation; and for related purposes. [Industrial Relations Amendment (Administrator) Bill 2024]
