statutory functions (Victorian quarry manager's certificate of competence) 2024

Explanatory Note: Under section 138(2)(b) of the Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2022, the regulator may be satisfied that an individual has the competence to exercise a statutory function only if the individual meets other criteria specified by the regulator for the function, by notice published in the NSW Government Gazette.
