Declaration of Parramatta Light Rail Transitway in the Local Government Area of City of Parramatta Council.




CLASS, NAME AND NUMBER	DESCRIPTION
Transitway No. 8013	In accordance with Section 52A of the Roads Act roadways to be declared as Transitway under PLR2 Enabling Works project are as follows: • From the intersection of Mary Street and Waratah Street at Melrose Park heading south along Waratah Street and the intersection of Waratah Street and Wharf Road, then south along Wharf Road up to the Ermington Boat Ramp and its car park as shown in Attachment A. • From the Intersection Hill Street and Footbridge Boulevard at Wentworth Point heading north to Wattlebird Road and south towards Half Street as shown in the Attachment A.

REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Hawkesbury River – Windsor Reach, between Windsor Road Bridge and the furthest downstream end of Windsor Reach.

Duration

9:00am to 5:00pm on the following dates:

- Friday 13 September 2024
- Saturday 14 September 2024
- Sunday 15 September 2024

Detail

Power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Hawkesbury River as specified above. A number of high-speed power vessels will be active in the area during the above times, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will comprise the width of the river between the points described above, and will be monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998).
