**ORDER**

**Withdrawal of Drug Authority**

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* an Order has been made on **Dr David Van Minh Tang (MED0001155256)**, of Homebush West NSW 2140, prohibiting him until further notice, as a medical practitioner, from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation.

This Order is to take effect on and from 10 September 2024.

ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* a direction has been issued that the Order that took effect on and from 1 June 2021, on **Dr Emma Hall (V10892)** of Glebe NSW 2037, prohibiting her as a veterinary practitioner, from supplying, having possession of or issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101 and 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 12 September 2024.
