MARINE SAFETY REGULATION 2016

EXEMPTION ORDER

HIRE AND DRIVE PERSONAL WATERCRAFT – LICENCE EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED ON LAKE MACQUARIE, NSW

Clause 140(1)

I, Paul Hearfield, Manager Waterways Operations, NSW Maritime, a delegate of Transport for NSW, pursuant to clause 140(1) of the Marine Safety Regulation 2016 (the Regulation), hereby **EXEMPT** the drivers of hire and drive personal watercraft used in conjunction with regulated tour activities conducted within the area of operations prescribed by Schedule 1 of this Order from the requirements of clause 103(1) of the Regulation - being the requirement to hold a personal watercraft driving licence – **SUBJECT TO** the conditions set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.

Object

The object of this Exemption Order is to allow unlicensed persons to drive personal watercraft in the context of a supervised 'tour' operation in a safe and responsible way in waters specified in Schedule 1 of this Order, and while the operation is subject to a Certificate of Operation under the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012* of the Commonwealth for the hiring out of personal watercraft.

Definition


In this Notice, "regulated tour activities" means unlicensed personal watercraft hire and drive tour activities conducted by Richard Goldman of Watersports NSW Pty Ltd T/A Jet Ski Safaris NSW, in accordance with the Certificate of Operation COO-39922-009 issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority.

SCHEDULE 1

REGULATED TOUR ACTIVITIES – AREA OF OPERATIONS

This Exemption applies only to drivers of personal watercraft participating in regulated tour activities conducted on the waters of Lake Macquarie as depicted in below (Graphic A). This is an imaginary line that the driver must always remain inside of (adjacent to the shore) whilst conducting the activity prescribed.

SCHEDULE 2

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. This Order does not apply to:
 - a) Any person who is ineligible to hold a boat driving licence or is the subject of a boat driving licence suspension or disqualification under the *Marine Safety Act* 1998, or an equivalent disqualification in any other State or Territory; or
 - b) A person who is the subject of a written notice from Transport for NSW specifying that this Order does not apply to the person.
- 2. This Order applies only to the driver of a hire and drive personal watercraft who is:
 - a) driving a personal watercraft in accordance with the terms and conditions of a hire agreement with Watersports NSW Pty Ltd T/A Jet Ski Safaris NSW; and
 - b) driving in accordance with specified waterway management instructions as required by the tour operator; and
 - c) wearing an appropriate lifejacket within the meaning of Part 6 of the Regulation; and

- d) not driving the vessel at a speed exceeding 30 knots; and
- e) a minimum of 16 years of age.
- This Order ceases to apply in the event that the regulated tour activities are no longer subject to a Certificate of Operation issued by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority.

Note:

Failure to comply with a condition of this Order by a personal watercraft driving means that the Exemption ceases to apply to that person and if the person does not hold a personal watercraft driving licence, the vessel owner and operator may be liable for an offence under State and National laws.

Publication

Pursuant to clause 140(3)(b) of the Regulation, this Order is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

This Notice takes effect on **6 September 2024** and will be in force for a period of 12 months from this date, unless revoked. This Order may be revoked at any time by Transport for NSW.

Location

Manning River, adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree.

Duration

6:00am to 5:00pm – Saturday 28 September 2024

Detail

Rowing Regattas and a race around Dumaresq Island will be conducted on the Manning River, adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Park, Taree as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will consist of:

- 1. A Zone from Endeavour Place boat ramp pontoon to and around Dumaresq Island, which will be indicated and monitored by control vessels;
- 2. A 5km Zone from the Taree Fish coop/Goat Island to the Manning River Rowing Club, Endeavour Place, Taree, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels; and
- 3. A 1km Zone between the Endeavour Place boat ramp and the Martin Bridge.

Provision has been made for vessels to transit the Zone during breaks in the racing. Control vessels will, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to transit the Zone.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zones during the times above.


An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be patrolled by Maritime and indicated by the presence of other control vessels.

Transit Lane

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).
